### Welcome / Announcements - Danya

### Principal's Report – Ms. Bowser

There are a few staffing updates.

- First, Ms. Payette will be out on maternity leave soon. Next Friday is her last day of the school year. She has been a great addition to our community this year. Ms. Watillo will be her sub for the remainder of the school year and they have been working closely to make it a smooth transition.
- For the Youngers class, we don't have a lot of staffing information that can be shared right now, but Ms. Bowser is hopeful that she can make an announcement by the end of April or beginning of May. There are contractural obligations that must be followed before a decision can be finalized. We do have a bit more flexibility as a choice school.

There were also questions about the staggered start for kindergarten students at the beginning of the school year. More will hopefully be shared about this soon once the teacher is set but there are also contractural considerations.

## **Teacher Report – (Ms. Subcleff) presented by Ms. Bowers**

- There will be an all school learning journey next Thursday to the Seattle Opera. Please bring a lunch, snack, water bottle and booster seat (if needed). There is also a photo release form from the Seattle Opera. If you don't want photos of your child that is fine, but please let us know.
- SBA testing will be starting soon and is a required state assessment for students in grades 3-5. The science test for 5th graders starts on May 2nd and will also be held on the 6th and 7th. The fourth grade students will have a substitute that morning. When the 3rd grade students complete their SBA testing the 2nd graders will have a sub in the morning. If students have headphones from home that they would prefer to use, you can

send them in, but we do have a school set. The best way to prepare your kids is to have them eat a good breakfast in the morning and get a good night sleep.

- Marketplace is coming soon and the kids are very excited.
- The all DCS end of the year gathering will be June 17th on the grassy field by the
  portables. The kids will eat and there will be games. More information is coming soon
  and volunteers will be needed.
- On Thursday, June 20th there is a pizza lunch at school for all DCS students.

# **DCS Family Camp - Camp Indianola - Jenn**

Camp will be Friday, May 31st to Sunday, June 2nd at Camp Indianola on the Kitsap Peninsula. Camp is a lot of fun and activities include playing on the beach, Gaga ball, basketball, talent show, crafts, games, s'mores at the campfire, etc. Food is included for Saturday breakfast, lunch and dinner and Sunday breakfast. Friday night dinner is not included and you cannot arrive at camp before 5pm. Camp is very affordable and includes food. This year we are responsible for cooking our own food, not the camp. The cost per person ages 2 and up is:

- Day trip = \$25 pp
- 1 Night = \$50 pp
- 2 Nights = \$75 pp

Sign-ups for camp will be coming out soon, along with sign-ups for volunteering (example: beach patrol, cabin inspection, cooking, etc.) while at camp. When you sign-up you can enter whether you have dietary restrictions. We are not serving pork, seafood, or peanuts. The cost is the same whether you camp or stay in a cabin. We have 80-85 beds which is a few less than last year, so be sure to sign-up right away to get your spot if you want to stay in a cabin.
