- <u>March Statements:</u> Same percentage from steering meeting: 54/71, 76% paid. 19/22-youngers, 21/24- middles, 14/25- olders
- Budget review:
 - Highlights different for next year
 - Increasing dues to \$350 per student- the budget was calculated for 72 students. We estimated our corporate matching would increase- already at \$9000 this year and estimating \$7000 next year.
 - We divided up line items that we didn't before and combined others. Because we're raising the dues, we didn't do a lot of change. We didn't try to cut a lot because of the due increase.
 - Spring Camp is estimated to cost the same- \$8400. We don't have the cost per family for Spring Camp yet.
 - Question: Why do we pay PayPal fees of \$360? Because there are fees taken we pay our dues. Since the dues are increasing so will the PayPal fees. Does PayPal have the box that says you can pay the fees? We will look into this. Will look into Zeffi instead.
 - Motion to approve budget (7:27)- Seconded. Votes: 30 votes yes.
